



STARS Student Choreography Process

Thank you for your interest in choreographing a student number in our February show.

We hope this year to be able to provide the students the ideal working environment to show their creativity as well as include as many dancers into the pieces as we can.

Please read through the following guidelines and procedures for submitting a student choreographed piece this year.

- Students that are 8 years of age and older are eligible to audition choreographed pieces
- Maximum two choreographers per piece
- Only one piece may be auditioned per dancer
- Maximum time limit for ALL numbers 2:10
- Dancers interested in participating in STARS can only be in one number

Choreographer Audition:

Saturday October 8th, 12:30pm

To be attended by choreographer(s) only.

To be presented in front of studio teachers in a closed audition. No student or parent viewing will be allowed.

Each interested student is to present a full choreographer's package. The following is to be included in the package:

- Student must come with **1 minute** of number completely choreographed and ready to audition
- Lyrics printed out
- Costume design/idea
- Number of dancers you would like to have in your dance (must have a minimum of 6 dancers in your piece)
- List of dancers you would prefer to have in your piece (no guarantee of this, placement of dancers will be done by Ms. Donna)

Process

- Choreographers will present numbers during audition along with complete package
- Teachers will review numbers and select a limited number of pieces to participate in show

- Teachers will review the choreographers package as well as list of dancers
- Ms. Donna will place students who want to participate in STARS into your number

Dancers wishing to participate in STARS

There will be an interest list in the office. If you are interested in being placed into a STARS student choreographed piece you must put your name on this list.

You will only be placed in one number.

Dancers who wish to participate in STARS will not have to attend the formal choreographer audition.

Important Dates

October 8 th	Choreographers Audition
October 11 th	Results will be posted at studio and on website, including dancers who have been selected for each piece.
December 10 th	All choreographers and dancers present progress
January 21 st	Final Showing of completed pieces. Number must be complete, costume must be complete.

Things to remember

- **Be Creative!!!! We want a variety of numbers in our show.**
- **Feel free to include dancers from different age groups**
- **Studio rehearsal time will be limited.**
- **All rehearsal time MUST be booked through office and marked on calendar**
- **Studio Teachers have priority for open studio time for privates, rehearsals, etc. You can be bumped by a teacher from your spot if necessary.**
- **Be prepared to work hard!!!**
